Mark Luttenton is the Associate Dean of the Graduate School, professor of biology, and research associate at the Annis Water Resources Institute, Grand Valley State University.

Mark will present his findings from a large-scale study of trout movement and habitat use in the Au Sable River. Using radio telemetry, Mark's group tracked more than 50 trout over two years to determine their daily and seasonal movements, and the types of habitat trout prefer.
